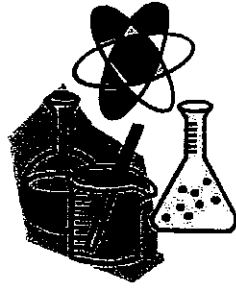
Free Children's Orthopedic Clinic
